

What you need to create your online presence and promote your project.

You

1. Head shot (preferably a vertical that can be cropped as a square) 300 dpi. 5 x 7"
2. Short Narrative Bio (not your resume). Write a one-paragraph version and a two-paragraph version.
3. Your updated resume/CV
4. Images of yourself in performance and/or images of your artwork 5x7" and 7x 5" 300dpi
5. A statement about your artwork /art practice.

Your project

1. Logo/graphic/photographic image that identifies your project.
2. A short narrative biography.
3. Project Description - a short elevator speech (approx. 50 word) about your project. (For Qcc people, mentioning NQAF/QCC/your name in the opening sentence of your Facebook page description will bring you higher up in a Google search)
4. A statement about the project - a more philosophical look at what and why you are doing what you are doing. This is different than the elevator speech. It can be a supplement to your short (50-word) project description.
5. A set of key images. Images that show what you are going to be doing. These can be your cast or some representations of your artwork. (2 or 4 images; vertical and horizontal; bold, eye catching, sexy!)
6. For the NQAF you'll need a set of short biographies of the artists in your show. You'll also need a head shot for each person. (Remember: these might be cropped into a square format and may be scaled down.)
7. Quotes about you or your show from fans or press. Tag lines. "The best performance of 2011," "I laughed, I cried," "Brilliant!"
